Siblings:

Encourage each other to live in view of God's mercy. Read Romans 12:1

- How do we live in view of God's mercy?
- Who in your life has encouraged you to live in this way? What are different ways you can encourage others to live in this way?

Love and <u>honor</u> each other.

Read Romans 12:9-10

• Men, how can you honor women as your sisters? Women, how can you honor men as your brothers?

Meet each other's physical needs.

Read Romans 12:13

- Describe a time when someone met your physical need. How did that make you feel? What was the result?
- Can you think of anyone who has a physical need that you can meet? What can you do to meet their need?
- How do you pursue hospitality in your everyday life? At home? At work? At school?

Encourage each other to respond to adversity as a <u>Christian</u>.

Read Romans 12:14-15

- Recall a time of adversity you have walked through. Did anyone encourage you during that time? How did they encourage you? What perspective did you gain during that experience?
- Do you know of anyone currently walking through adversity? How can you encourage them to respond as a Christian?

Sow seeds of peace.

Read Romans 12:17-18

- There is a difference between being a peacekeeper and a peacemaker. What is that difference?
- How can you be a peacemaker in your home? At work? At school?

Overcome evil with good.

Read Romans 12:21

• Jesus already conquered evil and has empowered you with the Holy Spirit to conquer evil as well. How do you practically do this in the day-to-day?
