• <u>Christmas</u> is the unfolding story of how God overcame the devastating effects that death has on humanity and creation. (Genesis 2:4 NIV)

The Modern Problem of Reading Genesis:

- <u>Scientism</u>: the view that only scientific claims are meaningful.
- <u>Philosophical Naturalism</u>: the view that nature is all that exists, therefore God cannot exist because He would be beyond nature. (Genesis 2:5-9; 15-18 NIV, Genesis 3:1-7 NIV)
- Death destroyed the four vital relationships with <u>God</u>, <u>self</u>, <u>others</u>, and <u>creation</u>.

How Does God Overcome Death?

- 1. He gives us life <u>Himself</u> (Jesus). Will you receive it? (John 1:4-5 NIV, Galatians 5:22-24 NIV, John 10:10 NIV)
- 2. Jesus died to kill <u>death</u>. Will you receive it? (Acts 5:30 ESV, 1 Peter 2:24 ESV)
