## How Do We Remain Faithful to God? (Matthew 1:18-21 CSB)

- 1. By faith in Christ, you must know that your <u>identity</u> is more important than your <u>reputation</u>. (Matthew 1:18-19 CSB)
- o Tsadiq (tsa-DEEK) one who studies the <u>Torah</u> seriously.
- o Am ha-aretz: one who does not observe the Torah; don't tithe, eat pork, hang out with Gentiles.
- 2. By faith in Christ, will you turn exclusively to the Lord for your <u>identity</u>? You are a child of <u>Abba</u>. (Galatians 4:4-7 CSB, 1 Thessalonians 3:11-13 CSB)
- o <u>Joseph</u> becomes like the Am ha-aretz in the eyes of the tsadiqim to provide room for a baby boy who gives the Am ha-aretz an <u>identity</u> better than the tsadiqim. (Matthew 1:21 CSB, Romans 3:22-24 NIV)

**Soul-tattoo:** 1. Daily, ask Jesus to help you live in your identity as <u>Abba's</u> child and for your <u>love</u> for everyone to increase.
