Recommit: Overcoming Pastor E. Paul Allen

- Open in prayer.
- Read Romans 8:28-39. Romans 8:28 starts with, "we KNOW that all things work together for the
 good." Sometimes we can "know" things but not believe them. Take a moment to provide examples
 of things you know but have a hard time believing.
- Remember: God is working to form Christ in us. Read Romans 8:28-29 and 1 Peter 5:10.
 - o 1 Peter 5:10 says that God "called us." Why is this important? How can you find hope in the truth that we are "called"?
 - o God is not only "calling" us, but He is "working" in us. What does it mean for "Christ to be formed in us"? Why is it important that Christ is being formed in us?
 - o If Christ is not being formed in us, what is?
- Remember: The cross is for us. Read Romans 8:30-32
 - The Cross was a symbol of terror and destruction used by the Romans to instill fear in their enemies and promote loyalty among their allies. How is it possible that a sign/symbol of devastating defeat can be turned into a symbol of glorious victory that we celebrate today?
 - o What is important about the progression in Romans 8:30 (He called, justified, glorified)?
 - o Based on Pastor Paul's teaching, what does it mean for the "cross to be for us"?
- Remember: God's resurrection power is in us. Read Romans 8:33-34.
 - In what ways have you faced accusation? Do any of the accusations relate to your belief and faith in God?
 - Why is it important for us to know that God's resurrection power is in us? What is the danger of forgetting or neglecting this tremendous truth?
- Remember: We are more than conquerors because of God's love in Christ. Read Romans 8:35-39 and Romans 5:2-5.
 - O How can you live a life of remembrance (God is forming Christ in us, the Cross is for us, the resurrection power is in us, we are more than conquerors)?

Soul-Tattoo:

- Remember: We are Overcomers because of Christ's love in us.
- o Remember: If you need help overcoming something in your life, we're here to help.
- Close by reading The Prayer of St. Patrick found below.
