Matthew 6:9-10 CSB

Our Father in heaven breaks the chains of <u>slavery</u> so we can <u>flourish</u>. (Exodus 4:23, Exodus 20: 1-2)

We flourish when we worship our Father in heaven. (Exodus 20:3)

We worship when we love God <u>completely</u> and discover who and whose we are as we come to see <u>ourselves</u> as God sees us. In this way, we become <u>secure</u> enough to become <u>other-centered</u> rather than self-centered. (Luke 10:25-28, Hebrews 9:11-14)
