Open in Prayer

Review the digital book *Insurgency* and read Matt 6:9-13 (page 9 of the *Insurgency* digital book).

- Take a moment and discuss how this book and teaching series has impacted your life and understanding of being called into His insurgency or uprising?
- The Lord's Prayer is <u>dynamite</u> in the face of <u>darkness</u>. Read the last paragraph at the end of page 11 of the *Insurgency* digital book ("When we pray the Lord's prayer...").
 - How is the Lord's Prayer dynamite in our dark places?
 - How does this give you hope and boldness to be living on mission?
- The Lord's Prayer invites us into the story of God, so we can become His <u>actors</u> on the stage of life.

Read Matt 6:9-14 and 2 Cor 5:19-20 CSB

- How can you be His ambassador at work? At school? With family and friends?
- Pastor Derwin writes on Page 48 of the *Insurgency* digital book, "Human flourishing and the Kingdom of God come to earth when we love people the way the Good Samaritan loved the man left for dead on the side of the road."
- We are baptized into Jesus' <u>insurgency</u>. Read Romans 6:3-4 and Luke 19:10 CSB
 - We are connected to Jesus in union with Him to walk in a new life. What is the purpose of this new life?
 - Give some practical ways you and your group can participate in His mission?
 - What are the names of your next-door neighbors? If you're not sure, this is a good starting place!
