How Do We Wait on God in Seasons of Betrayal?

Share a time in your life when you felt betrayed. How did you have to wait on God in the situation? What were you waiting for? Was it difficult to wait?

- Understand that you will be <u>betrayed</u> and that you will be a <u>betrayer</u>. Read Genesis 37:23-45.
 - Have you ever been a betrayer? What was that experience like?
- 2. <u>Grieve</u> your betrayal and leave it at the <u>cross</u>. Read Genesis 39:8-9.
 - Why is it important to grieve?
 - How do you leave the betrayal at the cross?
- 3. Trust the process (God's).

Read Genesis 39:21-23.

- Who was with Joseph throughout everything? Why does this make a difference?
- How have you felt God with you during seasons of betrayal?

Read Romans 8:28-29.

- What is the ultimate goal?
- In what ways have you seen yourself conformed to His image?
- 4. Turn your betrayal into a <u>blessing</u>. Read Genesis 50:20-21.
 - Think about a betrayal you've walked through. How did God bring about good in the situation?
 - What can you do to turn your betrayal into a blessing?
