Conversation Guide:

- Read **Psalm 51:6**. David wrote this psalm as a prayer of confession. He acknowledges his sin, knowing that God desires integrity. What does integrity mean? How is holiness tied into integrity? How have you demonstrated integrity in your life? At work, school, home?
- Read **I Corinthians 1:30-31**. Holiness is not something we strive for; it is already ours in Christ Jesus. What is the difference between striving for holiness and living out of holiness in Christ?
- Read **Colossians 3:1-3**. How do you occupy your mind with Christ? In verse 3, what does "for you died" mean to you? Why is it important to understand this concept?
- Read **John 14:15-17a**. The Holy Spirit convicts and speaks truth over us. How have you experienced the Holy Spirit convicting and bringing truth to your life?
- Read **Romans 6:11-13**. We can bring God's Kingdom to earth through our obedience. Is there an area of your life that you need to yield to Christ? What does obedience look like in your life right now? What does it mean to be a "weapon of righteousness"? How does the presence of Christ make a difference in your life, in your relationships?
- Take time to discuss this week's Soul Tattoo. How will praying through these verses help you to set your mind on things above and pursue holiness?
