- 1. Read Ephesians 5:25-33. Then pray, asking the Holy Spirit to make these verses a reality in your life.
- 2. How do you think your marriage would be impacted if you saw marriage as a sacred symbol that reflects Jesus' sacred covenant with you, His Bride, the Church?
- 3. Pastor Derwin and Vicki walked us through the acronym LOVE, which applies to not just those who are married, but to everyone.

Listen to each other's heart

- a. Read Ephesians 5:25. How are husbands to love their wives?
 Pastor Derwin said, "Because I am loved by Christ sacrificially, I'm empowered to love my spouse sacrificially."

Observe and Serve

- a. Read Ephesians 5:26
- b. Because of Jesus' love towards His Bride, the Church, His redemptive work makes us, His people:
 - Holy We are as sacred as Jesus and set apart as the Bride of Christ.
 - Clean We are eternally forgiven of our sin and are as spiritually pure as Christ.
- c. Pastor Derwin said, "Because I'm sacred (holy), forgiven (clean), and restored, I'm empowered to <u>serve</u> my spouse. Discuss this.

Value him / her

- a. Read Ephesians 5:27-33.
- b. A man's greatest desire is for his wife to respect him. Why is this important to a man?
- c. How do women in today's culture, in the Church and outside the Church, view respecting men?
- d. What are ways you can respect your husband?
- e. Pastor Derwin said, "Because I'm <u>valued</u> by Christ, I'm empowered to value my spouse." Discuss.

Experience Christ together (Prayer, Scripture, Serve)

- a. Pastor Derwin said, "The closer each of you get to Jesus the closer you will get to each other."
 - How does praying, reading Scripture, and serving each other draw you closer to Jesus and to each other?
