Siblings:

Encourage each other to live in view of God's mercy.

Read Romans 12:1

- How do we live in view of God's mercy?
- Who in your life has encouraged you to live in this way? What are different ways you can encourage others to live in this way?

Love and honor each other.

Read Romans 12:9-10

- Men, how can you honor women as your sisters? Women, how can you honor men as your brothers?

Meet each other's physical needs.

Read Romans 12:13

- Describe a time when someone met your physical need. How did that make you feel? What was the result?
- Can you think of anyone who has a physical need that you can meet? What can you do to meet their need?
- How do you pursue hospitality in your everyday life? At home? At work? At school?

Encourage each other to respond to adversity as a Christian.

Read Romans 12:14-15

- Recall a time of adversity you have walked through. Did anyone encourage you during that time? How did they encourage you? What perspective did you gain during that experience?
- Do you know of anyone currently walking through adversity? How can you encourage them to respond as a Christian?

Sow seeds of peace.

Read Romans 12:17-18

- There is a difference between being a peacekeeper and a peacemaker. What is that difference?
- How can you be a peacemaker in your home? At work? At school?

Overcome evil with good.

Read Romans 12:21

- Jesus already conquered evil and has empowered you with the Holy Spirit to conquer evil as well. How do you practically do this in the day-to-day?
