Conversation Guide:

Create a meaningful conversation. Feel free to adjust the questions as needed.

- In his sermon, Pastor Derwin shares that teammates ought to **CARE** for one another, meaning:

Carry each other's burdens.

Accept each other.

Rally each other towards love and good works.

Encourage each other to experience life in corporate worship and in your TC Group.

- Read **Galatians 6:1-3**. What kind of burdens is being referred to in this passage? How do we lovingly restore people when they are in sin? What is the law of Christ referred to in verse 2?

- Read **Romans 15:5-7**. Have you ever felt unaccepted? What was that experience like? Do you have a hard time believing you are fully accepted by Christ? If so, pray that the Holy Spirit would help you receive this truth: Know that you are fully accepted by Christ. Believing this, how can you now accept others?

- Read **Hebrews 10:22-24**. There are many cleansing rituals in the Old Testament, but what do these verses say about the cleansing we receive from Christ? Verse 24 says we ought to provoke each other to love and good works. Who is someone in your life who is rallying you towards love and good works? How do they do this? Who, and how, can you rally them to love and good works? Read **Hebrews 10:25**. Are you committed to gathering each week with the Church? Why is it important to experience life in corporate worship? How have you been encouraged when gathered corporately with other believers?
