A Gospel Friend is a person that makes you a better version of yourself.

GOSPEL FRIEND STORY:

Jorge and Maria came to Transformation Church in 2011. Although they are both native Spanish speakers and were used to attending Spanish-speaking churches, they were drawn by the vision of Transformation Church. As they listened to the preaching each week, relying on the Holy Spirit to bring clarity and understanding, they fell more in love with God and His multiethnic family. They began serving in various areas at TC – parking team, barista team, and the choir. Through these ministry teams, they have been able to make connections and gospel friendships that last. The language barrier has been transformed into a bridge across cultural lines.

Last year, they were able to join a TC Group for the very first time when we began offering Spanish-speaking small groups. What they love about their group is that they are finally able to have meaningful conversation about the sermons with full understanding and full expression in their native tongue. They have a group they can walk alongside with through life's ups and downs. And although their group is completely in Spanish, half of their members are native English speakers who wish to learn Spanish and connect with the Spanish-speaking community at TC. What a wonderful environment to grow in trust, loyalty, honesty, and presence.
