

# Who are the People of God?

SUMMARY:

When you think about your identity, what comes to mind? Maybe your thoughts go to your job, relationship status, family dynamics, or hobbies. But is this the true and primary identity of God's people?

When we put our faith in Jesus, we are adopted into God's family and receive a new identity. This is where we find our place in God's story as His beloved people. But, what does this mean? How should we see ourselves in light of this truth?

1 Peter 2:9-10 details our identity as the people of God. In this passage, we learn *who we are* and *whose we are*. The people of God are His chosen race of grace. We are God's prized possessions, His people of praise. Instead of living as slaves to sin, death, and evil, God's family consists of people who are living out their calling as born-again disciples of Jesus.

The most important thing about us is our identity as children of God. When we live accordingly, we are living as the royal priests and holy nation that God calls us to be.

# Upward
