Upward:

Review the different names for God below. How do each of these characteristics exhibit love?

Yahweh-Raah, "The LORD is our shepherd." (Psalm 23:1a)

Yahweh-Jireh, "The LORD will provide." (Psalm 23:1b)

Yahweh-<u>Shalom</u>, "The LORD is our peace." (Psalm 23:2)

Yahweh-Rapha, "The LORD will heal." (Psalm 23:3)

Yahweh-Tsidkenu, "The LORD is our righteousness." (Psalm 23:3b)

Yahweh-<u>Shammah</u>, "The LORD is there." (Psalm 23:4)

Yahweh-<u>Nissi</u>, "The LORD is our banner." (Psalm 23:5-6)

Inward:

Of the names listed above, which one resonates with you in your current season?

In what ways can you invite God to show you His love?



Outward:

Read 1 Peter 2:24-25. If you are a Christ-follower, remember that once you were a sheep going astray, but God pursed you and brought you back into the fold. Who is someone in your life that needs to be reminded of the Good Shepherd's unbreakable love?
