- In what ways have you felt God's presence throughout your life?
- How can we help people around us feel God's presence?

Read Hebrews 12:14-17.

- How do we make every effort to live at peace with others?
- Why is this sometimes difficult to do?
- In what ways have you felt God's peace throughout your life?

Read 2 Timothy 2:22.

- What are some distractions that may come up that would draw our attention away from God?
- What are we to pursue?

• What are some ways you can pursue these things?
