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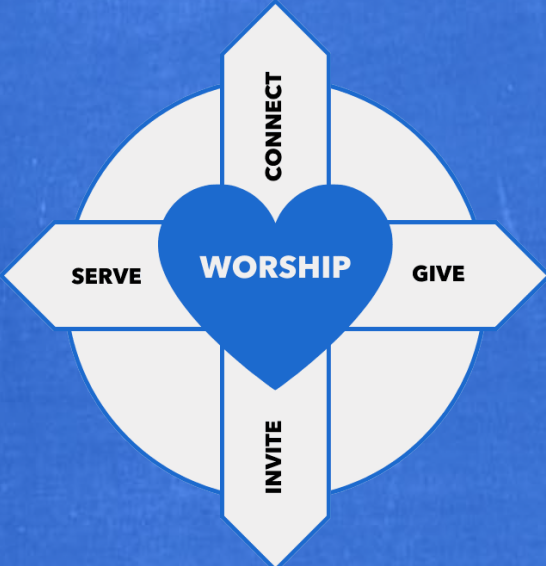

On December 14, we celebrated All-Give Sunday, praying for 100% participation in giving. This day supported translating the New Testament for two unreached people groups in Nigeria, partnering with Seed India to serve impoverished families in rural India, and advancing key initiatives at Transformation Church—including adding a right turn lane to TC Indian Land, securing a permanent location for TC Lake Wylie, and launching the Multiethnic Church Planting Network.
